Minutes

- Repairs to Building A roof as proposed by Albright Roofing are not needed as the board has already approved replacement of the roof.
- Screen repairs have been done.
- Gutter cleaning has been requested for mid-March by Affordable Work Orders contingent on seasonal leaf fall.
- Letters will be sent to unit owners with additional unapproved tenants.

Anne Kastner shared information relating to safety.

- Cameras may be cost prohibitive, require an assessment and would need to be monitored. Further research will be needed.
- A committee is needed to form a Crime Watch. Pinellas County Sheriffs provide a class and follow-up monitoring.

New Business:

- A question regarding percentage of units required to be owner occupied will be researched.
- Look into the possibility of getting a copy of the Association rules to all residents.
- When an urgent repair issue comes, up check all buildings so all related repairs can be done at the same time
