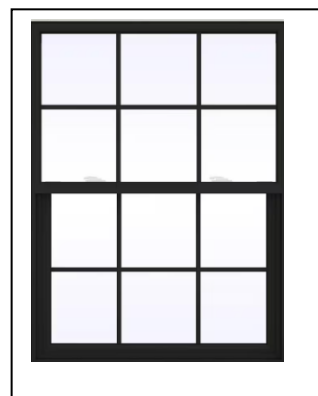

For condominiums, we must follow the most current law. Your contractor will provide you with that information. Note: as per our R&R, your contractor must be licensed and insured.
